The Brief

To provide low maintenance task & area lighting for memorial plaques and walkway areas surrounding plaques and water feature; To provide optically intriguing effects within several feature 'totem poles' which are a focal point of the park.

The challenge

The lighting must be absolutely vandal resistant and weatherproof, with the fibre optic light sources themselves hidden underground. Plaque lighting must provide no glare to the observer.

The solution

Digilin ELB 30 stainless steel 'eyelid' luminaires were selected for the plaques, UPB 75 40mm diameter solid brass down lights with borosilicate glass lenses were fitted to the timber beams of the pergola, those located on the inner perimeter fitted with narrow beam lenses for an enhanced dramatic effect. Totem poles were equipped with purpose built uplights fitted to the inside of the inspection panels. As the poles are stencilled with cut design elements, weatherproof lenses were incorporated. Fed by a six position colour wheel, the totem effect is playful and interesting. Two DB 300 light sources are fitted in two below ground pits with surface vents.

The outcome

A happy client, an outdoor space that has its artistic and architectural features enhanced with reliable, low maintenance vandal resistant efficient lighting. Fibre optics at its best.
