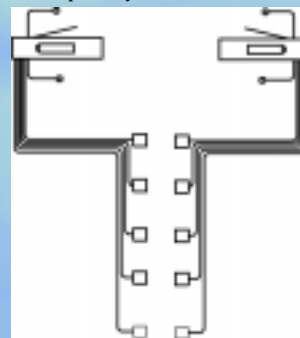

Fibre optic Layout



Entrance

10 x 200mm square textured glass tiles with "Domino" effect designate the entry point (4 x 1mm self jacketed fibres per tile).

4 in ground uplighters frame the entry by high lighting the sides of the columns (1 x SV150 .per uplight..1 x Gemini

Beckoning across the car park (easily visible a 100m away) is the club logo, Edge lit Acrylic 1200 x 1200 with wave effect to lower half providing interest and animation.

Ceiling

48 Acrylic cylindrical downlights with a sequenced and synchronised colour flow entices and leads on towards the Keno lounge and the rest of the club.

The loop at the end breaks the flow and provides a decision point, to visit the Keno lounge or go on.

(D100 downlight, SV25 cables with two synchronised Arcblaze 150H)

Stairs

Random colour changing steps provide functional lighting for a safety hazard, highlighting and delineating tread edges and changes of levels. At the same time an excitement is made of what could have been humdrum, encouraging exploration.

(SV25 cables in a simple, elegant polished brass fixture set into the balustrade)

Great care was taken over the selection of dichroic filter colours.

Colours were selected using samples of the custom weaved carpet to ensure sensitive and compatible results
